

Privacy Policy – Video Surveillance

In compliance with Spanish Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR) and Spanish Organic Law 3/2018 (LOPDGDD), we inform you about the processing of your personal data collected through the video surveillance system installed in the physical facilities located in Spain that are owned and operated by the data controllers listed below. This policy applies exclusively to the use of video surveillance in these locations.

2. PURPOSE OF PROCESSING

The purpose of the video surveillance system is to ensure the security of individuals, property, and facilities through access control and the detection of potentially unlawful acts.

3. LEGAL BASIS

The legal basis for processing is the legitimate interest of the data controller in ensuring the security of its premises (Art. 6.1.f GDPR).

4. DATA RETENTION PERIOD

Images will be stored for a maximum period of 30 days, unless they must be kept for a longer period due to incident investigation or legal/judicial requirements.

5. RECIPIENTS

No data will be disclosed to third parties, except in cases legally provided for, such as to law enforcement agencies or judicial authorities.

6. RIGHTS

You may exercise your rights of access, rectification, erasure, objection, restriction of processing, and data portability by sending a written request to the postal or email address of the data controller.

You also have the right to file a complaint with the Spanish Data Protection Authority (AEPD): www.aepd.es.

7. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

This processing does not involve automated decision-making or profiling. All cameras are properly signposted in accordance with legal requirements.
